# Earth Day Lesson Plan for Georgia-Pacific

Subject: ELA - Speaking & Listening

**Grade Level: 5** 

CCSS: S.L. 5.4, 5.5, 5.6

**Date:** 4-17-13

**Objectives:** Students will create a PSA on conservation and recycling, and present PSA to an audience (class)

## **Materials Needed:**

- YouTube Video "Green Pug Recycles"
- Presentation web tools (such as: Animoto, GoAnimate, Google Drive, Keynote, iMovie, etc.)
- Google Drive
- Student computers

## **Anticipatory Set: (lesson lead-in)**

- Watch YouTube Video "Green Pug Recycles"
- Discuss benefits of recycling and a clean environment
- Create a KWL chart (share doc with students to complete)

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## **Step-by-Step Procedures:**

- **1.** Using Google Drive, brainstorm ideas for an Earth Day PSA (Day 1)
- **2.** Allow students to work in groups of 2-3 to create a script for a 3-5 minute PSA (Day 1 Day 3).
- 3. Students work on video PSA on web tool of choice (Day 3 5)
- **4.** Students create a short (live) introduction to their PSA (Day 6)
- **5.** Students present PSA to class with live introduction (Day 7 9)

#### Closure:

- PSA's are uploaded to the class website and/or student blogs
- Students complete an evaluation form on the collaboration of their group
- Students complete the KWL chart

### **Independent Practice:**

- During the process, students will research answers to their questions that were generated on the KWL chart.
- Students will complete KWL chart as they reserach
- Students will be expected to research information for their PSA
